

Court Mandated Volunteers

Overview and Procedures

Volunteers seeking hours for court-ordered community service are eligible to assist in the warehouse. All shifts must be booked in advance and volunteers must provide a copy of their court documents and must have no felony convictions. Sort shifts and Special Event shifts are not eligible for court-mandated hours.

The Southwestern Region (Boise) warehouse accepts referrals from the Ada County Sherriff's office and the Ada County Misdemeanor and Probation Office. Volunteers must be at least 18 years of age and are scheduled to work Monday through Friday between the hours of 8am and 3pm. Each shift must be a minimum of three hours in length. Court mandated volunteers will not be accepted less than two weeks prior to their required completion date.
